Dear Resident

Welcome to the third edition of the Webber Row Newsletter. A&E Elkins Ltd are the Main Contractors responsible for the electrical upgrade works scheduled for your homes. We will be sending you monthly newsletters to keep you informed of the progress of works.

External works

We have commenced installing the new black powder coated trunking to the balconies of Overy House and Algar House.

This new trunking will contain both the new lateral mains cables as well as the communal balcony lighting

Surveys

Surveys have now been completed in 95% of the Webber Row properties and we would like to thank all the Council Tenants and Leaseholders who have provided access so far.

Lateral Trunking

In preparation for the lateral mains changeover, new cables will be run to your home's electrical meter. We will require access to each property to install the protective trunking that will contain these new cables and are currently booking appointments.

Remedial Works

During our electrical surveys, it has been highlighted that all council tenanted properties require minor upgrade works to their electrics. Appointments are currently being booked to complete these necessary upgrades.

If you have not yet had an electrical test, a lateral trunking appointment or you are a council tenant and have not had a remedial appointment booked, please contact Resident Liaison Officer Michael on 07772 302 153.

We work as part of the **Considerate Constructors Scheme**.
